

Recommend organizations eligible to participate in the City's 1997 Charitable Campaign

WHEREAS, Ordinance No 161964, adopted by Council on May 24, 1989, established standards and guidelines for conducting charitable fund-raising campaigns and authorized the use of the payroll deduction system for making donations to charities

WHEREAS, a Charitable Campaign Committee, composed of a representative appointed by the Mayor and each Commissioner, has been created pursuant to Chapter 5 10 of the City Code

WHEREAS, the Charitable Campaign Committee has established rules and guidelines in accordance with Chapter 5 10 of the City Code for participation in the 1997 Campaign

WHEREAS, an application was developed by the Charitable Campaign Committee and forwarded to agencies expressing interest in participating in the Campaign

WHEREAS, ten applications or written statements of intent to continue participation and one new application have been received and reviewed by the Charitable Campaign Committee


