Support proposed state-wide legislation that specifically identifies "road rage" aggressive actions, as heightened criminal offenses (Resolution)

- WHEREAS, "road rage" is a growing concern for Portland residents. Just last week an alleged "road rage" incident resulted in the death of an innocent woman
- WHEREAS. "road rage", is defined as operating a vehicle with reckless disregard for the rights of others or in a manner that endangers any person or property
- WHEREAS, "road rage" is reaching epidemic proportions across the country The National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA) estimates acts of "road rage" at least partially account for nearly two-thirds of trafficrelated deaths and one-third of crashes nationally
- WHEREAS, this problem will continue to worsen as our roads become more congested, with more vehicles traveling more miles each year. Locally, with increasing population and employment, Portland and the rest of the region will see a substantial increase in the demand on the transportation system Portland's vehicle miles traveled is projected to increase 27 percent from 1993 to 2010 (from the Portland Office of Transportation's Strategic Plan, 1996-2001)
- WHEREAS, Oregon is joining several states trying to pass legislation targeting acts of "road rage" aggression for increased criminal penalties

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Portland, Oregon, finds that acts of "road rage" should be identified for independent criminal sanction and supports state-wide legislation towards that end
