

RESOLUTION No. 35778

Formally request the transfer of certain Multnomah County tax foreclosed property to the City of Portland to be used as public street right-of-way and access control strips (Resolution)


WHEREAS, the City of Portland sees an immediate need for the properties to become public street right-of-way and access control strips, and
