- Support applications to Tri-Met for Portland Area Transportation Management funds from various organizations within the City of Portland. (Resolution)
- WHEREAS, implementation of the 2040 Growth Concept requires the use of alternative modes of travel in order to avoid unacceptable levels of congestion and to ensure that accessibility by alternative modes is attractive; and
- WHEREAS, Transportation Management Associations are typically nonprofit organizations made up of businesses and public agencies. They are important institutions for implementing strategies to increase the use of alternative modes of travel, which reduces traffic congestion and pollution, and improves commute options for their employees; and
- WHEREAS, Metro Council Resolution No. 98-2676 established a policy basis and funding strategy for Transportation Management Associations from Metropolitan Transportation Improvement Funds and State Transportation Improvement Funds; and
- WHEREAS, Metro allocated \$1,000,000 for disbursement over the next 4 years towards the development of Transportation Management Associations; and
- WHEREAS, applications to Tri-Met, as the administrator of those funds, is due October 14, 1999; and
- WHEREAS, support from local jurisdictions is an application requirement,
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City of Portland supports the separate applications of Columbia Corridor Association, Swan Island Business Association, Lloyd District Transportation Management Association and Association for Portland Progress to explore the formation of or formation and operations funds for Transportation Management Associations (TMAs) in order to promote the use of transportation alternatives within their individual geographic areas.
- FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution of support shall be communicated immediately to Tri-Met, the administrator of the Portland Area Transportation Management Association Funds.
