- Authorize the City Attorney to file an application to appear *amicus curiae* before the Supreme Court of the State of Oregon in <u>Johansen v. SAIF</u>, 158 Or App 672 (1999), CA A100445 (Resolution)
- WHEREAS, SAIF Corporation is in litigation with Paul D. Johansen regarding the applicability and interpretation of statutes relating to entitlement of temporary disability benefits and other procedural and substantive issues with respect to new medical conditions arising on a previously accepted claim, and
- WHEREAS, SAIF Corporation has petitioned to the Oregon Supreme Court asking for its review of the Court of Appeals decision on this litigation in <u>Johansen v. SAIF</u>, and
- WHEREAS, the issues raised in SAIF's litigation impact the processing of many of the City's claims; and
- WHEREAS, SAIF Corporation has estimates that if <u>Johansen v. SAIF</u> remains the law in the State of Oregon, the financial impact of the ruling in the workers' compensation system will be in the neighborhood of a quarter of a billion dollars (250 million), and
- WHEREAS, the Bureau of Risk Management advises that if <u>Johansen v. SAIF</u> remains the law in the State of Oregon, the City will have to bear significant additional costs on many of the City's workers' compensation claims, and
- WHEREAS, the City Attorney believes that participation by the City as an *amicus curiae* would assist obtaining review by the Oregon Supreme Court and assist the court in fully considering the implications arising from the decision in <u>Johansen v SAIF</u>; and
- WHEREAS, due to the short time limits provided by law, the City's *amicus* brief was due 10/6/99 before this resolution could be scheduled before the Council;
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Attorney's application dated 10/6/99 to the Oregon Supreme Court for permission for the City of Portland to appear *amicus curiae* in the case of <u>Johansen v SAIF</u>, 158 Or App 672 (1999) is authorized.
