City Council Public Hearings will be held on the third Wednesday of each month in the evenings, beginning at 6 00 p m and, when appropriate for issues of particular neighborhood concern, at geographically dispersed locations

The City Auditor is directed to provide the appropriate public notice regarding this schedule change, and

#### BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT:

Council will evaluate the effectiveness and cost of this schedule change and make further amendments as necessary
