RE: Resolution to approve the naming of Brunish Hall in the New Theatre Building of the Portland Center for the Performing Arts.

I. RECOMMENDATION/ACTION REQUESTED:

Approve the permanent naming of Brunish Hall in the Portland Center for the Performing Arts New Theatre Building.

II. BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS:

MERC has identified unfunded capital project needs for the Portland Center for the Performing Arts including design and construction for completion of the 4th floor space of the New Theatre Building.

The MERC Commission acted by Resolution to approve a Policy for Naming Buildings, theaters and spaces at the Portland Center for the Performing Arts, which includes a schedule of gifts appropriate for a number of locations in the three PCPA buildings, including the unfinished 4th floor space of the New Theatre Building.

MERC accepted, by resolution, a proposal for a gift of \$350,000 from an anonymous donor for the permanent naming of the 4th floor space of the New Theatre Building.

Approve a naming Brunish Hall in the New Theatre Building of the Portland Center for the Performing Arts (Resolution)

WHEREAS, the City of Portland is owner of the facilities comprising the Portland Center for the Performing Arts (PCPA) and has contracted with Metro for their management and operation together with other regional facilities through the Metropolitan Exposition-Recreation Commission (MERC); and

WHEREAS, MERC has identified unfunded capital project needs for the Portland Center for the Performing Arts including design and construction for completion of the 4th floor space of the New Theatre Building; and

WHEREAS, the MERC Commission acted by Resolution on May 13, 1992 to approve a Policy for Naming Buildings, Theatres, and Spaces at the Portland Center for the Performing Arts which includes a schedule of gifts appropriate for a number of locations in the three PCPA buildings including the unfinished 4th floor space of the New Theatre Building; and

WHEREAS, the MERC Commission acted by Resolution on January 20, 1999, to accept a proposal for a gift of \$350,000 from an anonymous donor for the permanent naming of the 4th floor space of the New Theatre Building; and

WHEREAS, the City of Portland City Council finds that the 4th floor naming proposal and gift is consistent with policies and provided critical resources for addressing otherwise unfunded capital improvement project necessary to the long term benefit of the PCPA facilities; and

WHEREAS, the design and construction of a multi-purpose arts space was funded through the resources of two naming gifts and was completed for dedication and opening on February 11, 2000 when the name of the donor was revealed;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City of Portland approves the permanent naming of Brunish Hall in the PCPA New Theatre Building and commends the donor for his generosity in this gift to the community and to the well-being of its performing arts facilities.
