

ORDINANCE No. 182935

*Extend the date of the privileges for regular disabled person parking permits (Ordinance; amend Section 16.20.640)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. On January 2, 2008, Portland City Council approved Ordinance No. 181507, which temporarily extended the privileges for regular disabled person parking permits in the City of Portland meter districts until June 30, 2008.
2. On December 19, 2007, Portland City Council adopted Resolution No. 36562, which established a Disabled Parking Task Force to develop recommendations for Council on the implementation of Oregon State Senate Bill 716.
3. On June 11, 2008, Portland City Council approved Ordinance No. 181914, which temporarily extended the privileges for regular disabled person parking permits in the City of Portland meter districts until December 31, 2008.
4. On November 19, 2008, Portland City Council approved Ordinance No. 182345, which temporarily extended the privileges for regular disabled person parking permits in the City of Portland meter districts until June 30, 2009.
5. This task force was formed in January 2008, is composed of members of the disabled community in the majority, business and neighborhood association interests, and city staff, and has held ten meetings between February 2008 and March 2009.
6. This task force has worked together to craft recommendations for City Council and submitted a Report to Council on June 3, 2009. Staff recommends a two-year pilot to determine whether SB 937 will have the desired effect of curbing unlawful use of disabled permits before considering other changes.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. Section 16.20.640, Disabled Parking Permit, is amended by changing the expiration date of subsection F. as follows:

F. Parking privileges for vehicle parking utilizing Section 16.20.640 will be extended under Senate Bill 716 Section 7 (3). All regulations within this Section will be granted and enforced; this Section will expire on ~~June 30, 2009~~ June 30, 2011.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because the initial timeframe of June 30, 2009, cannot be met without it; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
