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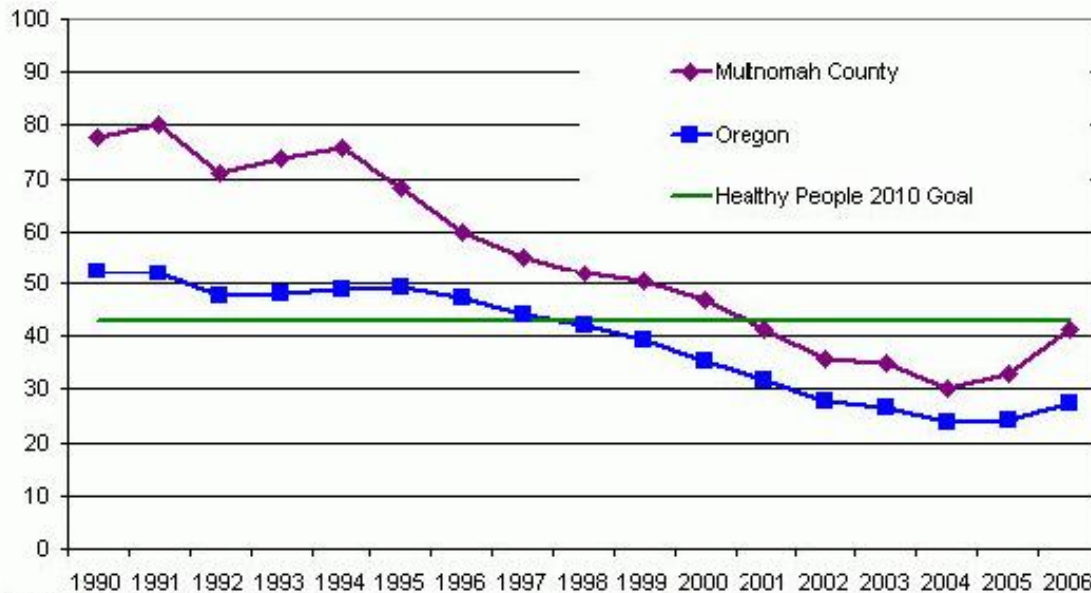
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26 Teen Pregnancy - Printable Version - Edit Content

Reduce the pregnancy rate per 1,000 females ages 15-17.

After dropping to a low of 30.2 per 1,000 females ages 15 to 17 in 2004, the teen pregnancy rate for Multnomah County has taken a disturbing trend reversal. It climbed to 41.2 in 2006, nearing the national Healthy People 2010 goal of 43 per 1,000. Nationally, the CDC reported that teen births (the largest part of teen pregnancies) also increased in 2006 after years of large declines.
