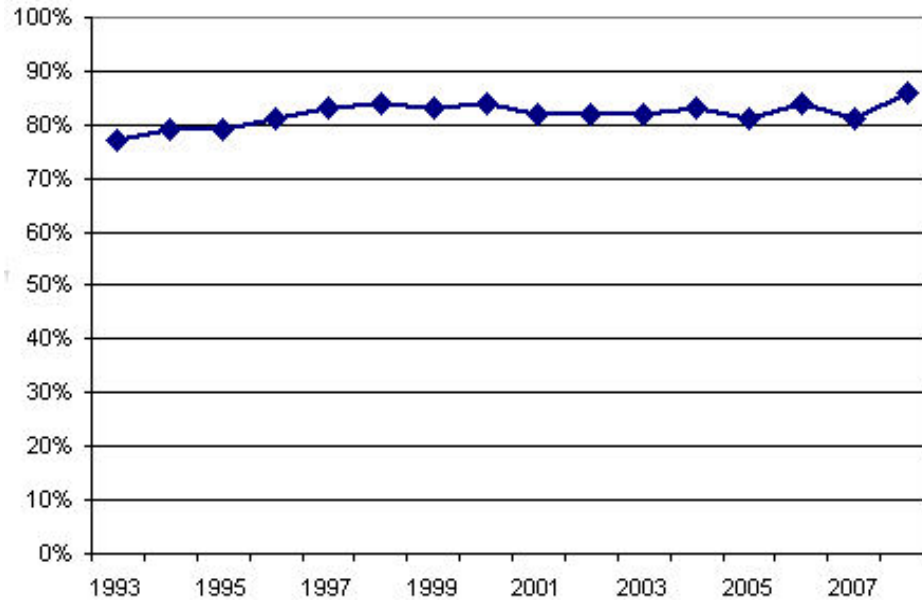


61 Neighborhood Livability - Printable Version - Edit Content

Increase the percentage of people who rate their neighborhood livability high.

In 2008, 86% of Portland residents rated their neighborhood livability as "very good" or "good", up 9 percentage points from 1993. Also in 2008, only 4% of the city's residents rated their neighborhood livability as "bad" or "very bad."
