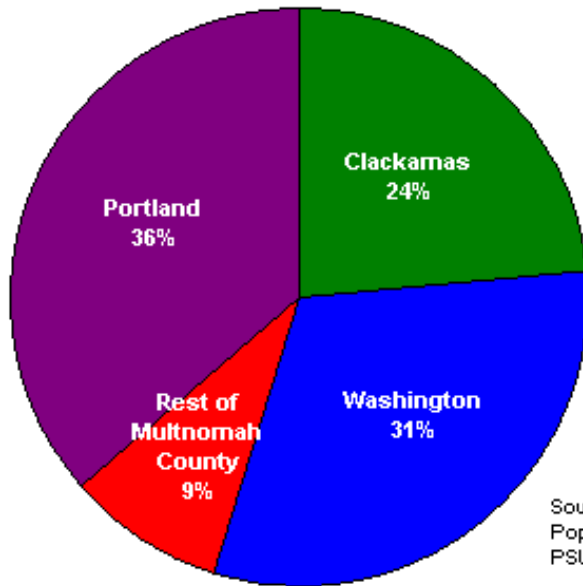


72 Population Growth - Printable Version - Edit Content

Monitor the percentage of the Portland Metropolitan area population growth since 1990 occurring within the City of Portland.

Portland had a 33% share of the tri-county population growth between 1990 and 2002. However, during that same time span, Washington County's share of the total has been steadily increasing, while Multnomah County's (in which the City of Portland is predominantly located) has been shrinking. In 2002, 36% of the regional population resided in the City of Portland.

Percent Share of Tri-County Population, 2002

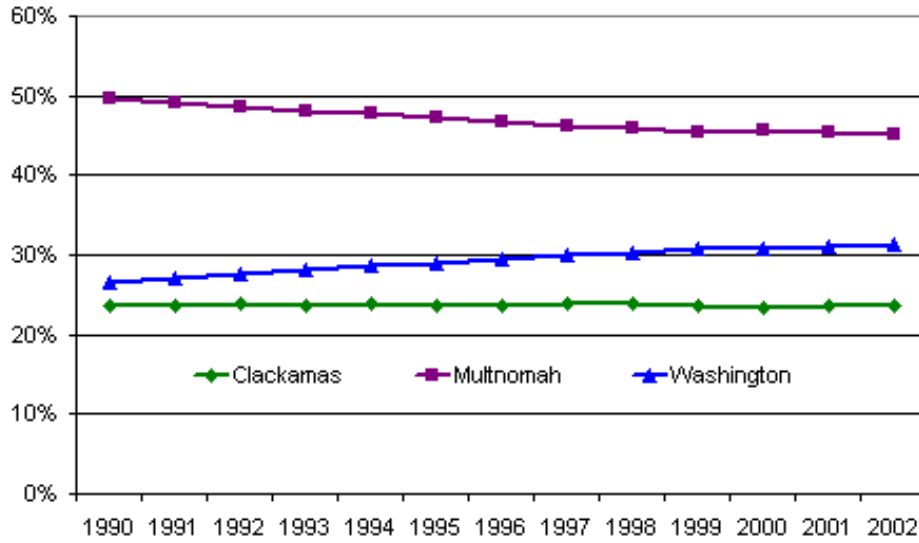
