THOSE PRESENT WERE: Mayor Clark, Presiding; Commissioners Blumenauer, Bogle and Kafoury, 4.


OFFICERS IN ATTENDANCE: Joan Engert, Acting Clerk of the Council, and Jeff Rogers, City Attorney.
