

ORDINANCE No. 183082

* Accept a \$125,000 grant from the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Bureau of Justice Assistance FY 2009 Competitive Grant for the Gang Resistance Education and Training Program (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The U.S. Department of Justice (USDOJ), Office of Justice Programs (OJP), Bureau of Justice Assistance (BJA) has awarded funding for the Gang Resistance Education and Training Program.
2. The City of Portland, Oregon Police Bureau wishes to accept \$125,000 in Level III grant funding, which will aid in the delivery of the Elementary and Middle School curricula as well as the G.R.E.A.T. Families and Summer Components.
3. The USDOJ will reimburse the City a maximum of \$125,000 to fund program expenses, including two 0.03 FTE's (the Regional Administrator and the Assistant Regional Administrator), travel, supplies and intra-agency expenses required to operate the G.R.E.A.T. Local program for 12 months. The remaining personnel costs, two 0.97 FTE's, will be funded by the 2009 G.R.E.A.T. Regional grant, if awarded.
4. The grant requires a 10 percent non-federal match, which will consist of additional bureau program staff time funded with existing Police Bureau FY10 General Fund appropriation within the Tactical Operations Division.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland a grant from the U.S. Department of Justice in the amount of \$125,000.

- b. The FY 2009-2010 budget is hereby amended as follows:


