ORDINANCE No. 183425

*Extend contract with the Alliance for Community Traffic Safety for one year and increase by \$8,000 for child safety seat assembly services (Ordinance; amend Contract No. 30000066)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The city's Safe Routes to School Program works with schools, neighborhoods, and community organizations to encourage students & families to get to and from school in ways that reduce traffic, increase safety, build strong bodies & clear minds, and provide a cleaner environment.
- 2. The Alliance for Community Traffic Safety (ACTS) was selected through a competitive bid process to provide child safety seat assembly services to Pre-K through 1st grade students at 25 Portland elementary schools in Portland.
- 3. The city is interested in having ACTS continue to provide these services and is able to fund child safety seat assembly services to Pre-K-1st grade students in 25 elementary schools in Portland. A provision in the Request for Proposals allowed for a renewal for up to 3 years in the event that the city was satisfied with the contractor's performance.
- 4. The Bureau's level of confidence in the cost estimates for this project is high, and funds are included in Transportation's FY 09/10 and will be included in the FY 10/11 proposed budgets.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. That the Commissioner-in-Charge and Auditor are authorized to amend Contract No. 30000066 with the Alliance for Community Traffic Safety, to add one year and \$8,000 in a form substantially in accordance with the amendment attached to the original of this ordinance and, by reference, made a part hereof.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because the existing contract is set to expire on January 30, 2010 and the parties wish to continue providing child safety seat assembly services without a gap in services; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
