In 1995, the City, Portland Development Commission (PDC) and other local government agencies were party to a disparity study responsible for the review of fair contracting practices. The Bureau of Purchases, now known as the Bureau of Internal Business Services (BIBS) - Procurement Services, provide oversight, compliance and certification services, data entry, project tracking, statistical reports and outreach services for the PDC and the City, as well as reports to Council regarding program results.

In August 2009, Council approved Ordinance No. 183122 resulting in City Contract No. 30000815. This authorizes an \$831,000 contract with BBC Consulting (BBC) to provide an in-depth review of the City and PDC's fair contracting practices, called the 2009 Disparity Study (Study). The Study period is from July 1, 2004 to June 30, 2009.
