

**ORDINANCE NO. 183436**

\* Amend contract with Moore Excavation, Inc. to increase compensation for the Annual Pipe Cleaning and Investigative Service (Ordinance; amend Contract No. 41098)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council Finds:

1. The City of Portland entered into Contract No 41098 with MEI Group, dba Moore Excavation, Inc., for an annual requirement contract to furnish Labor, Equipment, and Material for emergency pipe cleaning and investigative services.
2. Demand exceeded the original estimates and additional funding is required in order to continue the on call ability until the contract expires on May 31, 2010.
3. The contract will be amended to increase funding by \$600,000. The new contract will be \$1,800,000. Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY 2010 Budget. Bureau of Environmental Service for various Capital Improvement Projects and operating funds

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. Upon the council's acceptance, the Purchasing Agent is authorized to execute an amendment to the contract No. 41098, in a form substantially in accordance with the amendment attached as Exhibit A, for the purpose described in Section 1, in the amount of \$600,000.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver checks when demand is presented and approved by proper authorities.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because it is essential that the Bureau of Environmental Services maintains the ability to provide immediate maintenance and investigative services. Therefore this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council




