Budget Advisory Committee  
\$100 Program Allocation Exercise Results  
January 5, 2010**

*On January 5, 2010 the PHB budget advisory committee conducted a prioritization exercise wherein each of the nine members present allocated \$100 amongst the programs listed below. The results are as follows.*

**Shelter and Emergency Services [ \$125 / 14.0% ]**

Night by night safety off the streets

**Rent Assistance – Short-Term [ \$85 / 9.5% ]**

Homelessness prevention and rapid re-housing

**Transitional Housing [ \$85 / 9.5% ]**

Program-supported housing for 6 months to 2 years

**Rent Assistance – Longer-Term [ \$80 / 9.0% ]**

Service-supported rent assistance to help people experiencing homelessness transition from streets to permanent housing

**Rental Access and Stabilization [ \$85 / 9.5% ]**

Human services that help people find, enter and retain rental housing

**Rental Housing Development and Finance – 0-30% MFI [ \$90 – 10.0% ]**

Deeply affordable homes for people experiencing homelessness / people with disabilities

**Rental Housing Development and Finance – 30-60% MFI [ \$90 – 10.0% ]**

Poverty-wage and low-wage housing

**Rental Housing Development and Finance – 60%+ MFI [ \$80 / 9.0% ]**

Living-wage housing

**Homebuyer / Homeowner – Access Services [ \$40 / 4.0% ]**

Homebuyer coaching, financial literacy, homebuyer education and fairs

**Homebuyer / Homeowner – Retention Services [ \$55 / 6.0% ]**

Foreclosure counseling, home repair, rehabilitation, lead hazard control

**Homebuyer / Homeowner – Financial Assistance [ \$85 / 9.5% ]**

First mortgage, down payment assistance to first-time homebuyers
