

ORDINANCE No. 183449

* Authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement with Portland Public Schools for transportation related to Portland Multnomah Youth Corps – Career + College Exploration program (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Based on the findings in the Connected by 25 research report, only 57% of 9th graders entering Portland Public Schools (PPS) graduate within four years. Furthermore, the transition from 8th to 9th grade is a pivotal time for students who struggle academically.
2. The Mayor and Multnomah County Chair Ted Wheeler have convened an Education Cabinet focused on increasing the graduation rate by 50% within four years. The Education Cabinet has sponsored three initiatives including *Portland Multnomah Youth Corps (PMYC)*.
3. The Council previously approved funding for youth employment and career preparation, as part of the Summer Youth Employment Program (SYEP) in the FY 2007-08 Fall Budget Adjustment Process. Ordinance No. 181456.
4. Pursuant to that funding, the PMYC – Career + College Exploration program for incoming 9th graders provided academic support plus career and college experiences to over 400 students through a series of career and college site visits across the metro area.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Purchasing Agent and Auditor are authorized to execute an Intergovernmental Agreement with Portland Public Schools to provide transportation services for PMYC career and college site visits. The Agreement shall be in a form substantially in conformance with the IGA attached hereto as Exhibit A.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because pursuant to a sole source agreement, PPS had authorized its transportation provider, First Student, to supply busses for these trips. PPS has paid First Student for its transportation services and now intends to seek reimbursement from the City, therefore this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.


