

ORDINANCE No. **183453**

Apply for a grant from the State of Oregon Department of Environmental Quality for \$38,170 to allow School and Community Reuse Action Project to initiate a pilot project. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. In April 2006, the City of Portland Council passed Resolution No. 36423 establishing goals for the solid waste and recycling system, including a 75% recycling rate by 2015.
2. Portland City Code, Section 17.102.270 requires businesses to recycle 75% of their waste and this grant to SCRAP will help businesses meet that goal.
3. SCRAP seeks to develop a pilot project to make it easier for local businesses to donate their waste materials for creative reuse. SCRAP will provide education and a process by which Portland businesses and manufacturers can donate waste materials for reuse creatively by the community rather than deposit them into the landfill. SCRAP will provide local businesses with convenient, on-site containers, an educational presentation, pick-up and drop-off service via a biodiesel fueled van.
4. The Department of Environmental Quality provides grants to local jurisdictions around the State. By law, the grants must go to local governments, but local governments may contract with community groups, private individuals, non-profit organizations, schools, businesses or chambers of commerce to implement grant-funded projects.
5. The City's Solid Waste and Recycling program will pass this grant, if awarded, to SCRAP for this project.
6. No City match is required.

NOW, THEREFORE, the council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to make application to the Department of Environmental Quality for a grant in the amount of \$38,170.00.
- b. The Mayor is authorized to provide such information and assurances for the grant period.
