

ORDINANCE No. 183454

Apply for a grant from the State of Oregon Department of Environmental Quality for \$41,372 to allow Community Warehouse to run the Furniture Recovery Project. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. In April 2006, the City of Portland Council passed Resolution No. 36423 establishing goals for the solid waste and recycling system, including a 75% recycling rate by 2015.
2. Portland City Code, Section 17.102.270 requires businesses to recycle 75% of their waste and this grant to Community Warehouse will help businesses meet that goal.
3. Community Warehouse seeks to expand businesses sustainable practices divert reusable furniture and household items from landfills and reduce the upstream impacts related to production and transport by redistributing quality reusable furniture to low income individuals and families. The project will expand the ability to solicit and accept furniture and other items from hotels, restaurants and businesses that are remodeling or closing.
4. The Department of Environmental Quality provides grants to local jurisdictions around the State. By law, the grants must go to local governments, but local governments may contract with community groups, private individuals, non-profit organizations, schools, businesses or chambers of commerce to implement grant-funded projects.
5. The City's Solid Waste and Recycling program will pass this grant, if awarded, to Community Warehouse for this project.
6. No City match is required.

NOW, THEREFORE, the council directs:


- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to make application to the Department of Environmental Quality for a grant in the amount of \$41,372.00.
