ORDINANCE No. 183471

*Accept a grant in the amount of \$1,366,000 from the Oregon Department of Transportation to design and construct bicycle and pedestrian improvements along SE 52nd Ave and NE 53rd Ave between SE Woodstock Blvd to NE Thompson St (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds

- 1. In 1996, Council adopted the Portland Bicycle Master Plan which included the 'NE/SE 50's Bikeway', a 6.7 mile North-South bikeway along SE 52nd Avenue and NE 53rd Avenue.
- 2. On June 28, 2006, Council adopted Resolution 36422 that authorized the Portland Bureau of Transportation (PBOT) to submit for the 2008-11 Metropolitan Transportation Improvement Program (MTIP) Transportation Priorities process.
- 3. In 2007, PBOT was awarded a \$1,366,000 MTIP grant to build the 50's Bikeway. The 50's Bikeway project will design and construct bicycle and pedestrian improvements along SE 52nd Avenue and NE 53rd between SE Woodstock Boulevard and NE Thompson Street. The project will include traffic calming treatments, bicycle lanes, and signals to assist pedestrian and bicycle crossing at arterial roadways.
- 4. The Bureau's level of confidence in the cost estimates for this project is low. The cost estimate for the design and construction will be developed during the development phase.
- 5. PBOT has the resources in its existing budget to provide for the local match requirements of this grant

NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland a grant from the Oregon Department of Transportation to design and construct bicycle and pedestrian improvements along SE 52nd Avenue and NE 53rd Avenue between SE Woodstock Boulevard to NE Thompson Street in the amount of \$1,366,000.
- b. The FY 2008/2009 budget is hereby amended as follows:

GRANTS FUND

Fund 217001 Business Area – TR00 Bureau Program Expenses - \$1,366,000 Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would unnecessarily delay the City's ability to perform the activities authorized by the grant; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
