ORDINANCE No. 183481

Authorize the Director of the Bureau of Environmental Services to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement with the City of Lake Oswego to work cooperatively to improve habitat for native species in the Tryon Creek Confluence area Project No. E08958 (Ordinance)
The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. On March 8, 2006, the Council adopted the Portland Watershed Management Plan which affirms the City's commitment to a watershed approach for natural resource protection and enhancement.
- 2. In 2007, the Council approved an IGA with Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) for Phase I of the Tryon Creek Confluence Habitat Enhancement. The project removed a fish passage barrier. ODOT constructed the project in Summer 2008, and maintains all project elements within ODOT right-of-way.
- 3. The Bureau of Environmental Services (BES) seeks to work with the City of Lake Oswego on Phase II of the Tryon Creek Confluence Habitat Enhancement in an area that includes certain real properties owned by Lake Oswego and by the City of Portland at the confluence of Tryon Creek and the Willamette River. Phase II will enhance approximately 900 feet of Tryon Creek, beginning at its confluence with the Willamette River. The project will include laying back the banks to improve floodplain connectivity, the placement of large wood to improve spawning and rearing for Endangered Species Act-listed salmonids, the placement of upland logs for improved terrestrial habitat and removing invasive plants from approximately 3.5 acres and revegetating with native species.
- 4. This Intergovernmental Agreement outlines the intentions of the parties to work together on the Tryon Creek Confluence Habitat Enhancement Project. No funds are affected.

NOW, THEREFORE, the council directs:

a. The Director of the Bureau of Environmental Services is authorized to execute an Intergovernmental Agreement with the City of Lake Oswego for the purpose described in Section 1.
