

ORDINANCE No. 183482

Authorize a contract with the lowest responsible bidder for the construction of the Tryon Creek Confluence Habitat Enhancement Project No. E08958 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. On March 8, 2006, the Council adopted the Portland Watershed Management Plan which affirms the City's commitment to a watershed approach for natural resource protection and enhancement.
2. Environmental Services has partnered with the City of Lake Oswego, Metro, and community members to prepare construction contract documents to enhance approximately 900 feet of Tryon Creek, beginning at its confluence with the Willamette River. The project will include laying back the banks to improve floodplain connectivity, the placement of large wood and boulders to improve spawning and rearing for Endangered Species Act-listed salmonids, the placement of upland logs for improved terrestrial habitat and removing invasive plants from approximately 3.5 acres and revegetating with native species.
3. The estimated construction cost is \$474,000. Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY 2010 and FY 2011 Budgets, Bureau of Environmental Services, Project Number E08958. The level of confidence in this estimated construction cost is optimal.


NOW, THEREFORE, the council directs:

- a. The Commissioner of Public Affairs and Auditor are authorized to execute a contract with the lowest responsible bidder for the purpose described in Section 1, in the amount of \$474,000.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.
