

ORDINANCE NO. 183507

* Authorize an agreement with the Council for the Homeless in Vancouver Washington up to \$10,000 to provide Homeless Management Information System consultation services.
(Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

SECTION 1. The Council finds that:

1. Council for the Homeless (CFTH) has made available \$10,000 for Homeless Management Information System (HMIS) consultation services.
2. Portland Housing Bureau manages HMIS and has been working with CFTH informally in regards to HMIS and the Bridges to Housing program.
3. The Council now desires to enter into agreement for \$10,000 to provide for HMIS consultation services to CFTH.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Commissioner of Public Works and Auditor are hereby authorized to execute the Homeless Management Information System (HMIS) consultation services agreement in a form substantially in accordance with the attached Exhibit A for the purpose and amounts described in Section 1.
- b. The Mayor and City Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the FY 2009-10 Budget, when demand is presented and approved by the proper authorities.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because delay in funding would interrupt the Portland Housing Bureau's ability to provide services under this agreement; therefore, this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
