ORDINANCE No. 183509

Authorize an agreement with the Community Music Center, Inc. to provide additional services and programs through the Community Music Center (Ordinance).

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Community Music Center, Inc. (CMC), a non-profit organization, and the City have successfully worked together since 1960 to provide services and programs at the Community Music Center.
- 2. CMC and the Bureau of Parks and Recreation wish to enter into a new agreement that reflects CMC's desire to co-sponsor the programs at the Community Music Center by providing musical instruments, scores and recordings through the Center's library, and funds to supplement the wages of instructors that exceed 50% of the fees collected up to certain caps.
- 3. The Director of the Bureau of Parks and Recreation and the Community Music Center, Inc. have proposed an Agreement to define the rights and obligations of both parties in the operation of this program.
- 4. The term of this agreement shall be from July 1, 2009 through June 30, 2014. CMC also has an option to renew for one additional five year term.
- 5. The attached agreement defines the relationship that the Bureau of Parks and Recreation and the Community Music Center, Inc. has developed and fostered since 1960.

NOW, THEREFORE, The Council Directs:

a. That the Commissioner-in-Charge of the Bureau of Parks and Recreation is authorized to execute an Agreement on behalf of the City substantially in the form of the Agreement attached to this Ordinance as "Exhibit A" with the Community Music Center, Inc. for enhanced services and programs at the Community Music Center.
