ORDINANCE No. 183527

Accept a \$98,000 grant from Oregon Department of Transportation to study crash data and develop a safety action plan report for the top-ten high crash corridors in Portland and support a regional traffic safety committee discussion on transportation safety. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds

- 1. Portland Bureau of Transportation applied to Oregon Department of Transportation on December 22, 2009 for a grant in the amount of \$98,000 to study and develop a safety action plan report for the top-ten high crash corridors in Portland and support a regional traffic safety committee discussion on transportation safety; and
- 2. Oregon Department of Transportation notified the City of Portland that it will award Portland a grant in the amount of \$98,000, effective January 5, 2010, to study and develop a safety action plan report for the top-ten high crash corridors in Portland and support a regional traffic safety committee discussion on transportation safety.

NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland a grant in the amount of \$98,000 from the Oregon Department of Transportation to study crash data and develop a safety action plan report for the top-ten high crash corridors in Portland and support a regional traffic safety committee discussion on transportation safety.
