-History of project – The Department of Homeland Security (DHS), through its Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA), has offered the Assistance to Firefighters Fire Grant Program since 2001. The grant funds a variety of programs including those to enhance emergency operations, firefighter safety, and prevention efforts.
