* Amend contract with SAP Public Services, Inc. to provide additional post go-live stabilization consulting services for \$200,000 for City SAP Enterprise Resource Planning system implementation (Ordinance; amend Contract No. 37969)

2) Purpose of the Proposed Legislation:

The City requires additional post go-live stabilization consulting services from SAP Public Services, Inc. for City SAP Enterprise Resource Planning system, with particular resources in 1) Time Management and Payroll consulting to support continuing HCM stabilization efforts, planned calendar year-end activities, W-2 and 1099 production; 2) Security consulting to support the stabilization of HCM security model, required SAP system updates/patching, the roll out of Employee Self-Service (ESS) and as needed break/fix support and knowledge transfer to the City's new SAP Security lead position (hire date 11/16/2009); and 3) general on demand remote consulting services. The majority of the consulting services were anticipated and funding in place, however, the extent of the HCM stabilization effort necessary, delays in the roll out of the Employee Self Serve module (ESS), and a prolonged recruitment process to hire a qualified City SAP Security lead, resulted in an additional \$200,000 expense to cover work through early 2010. Execution of Amendment No. 7 to Contract No. 37969 will provide the additional funds necessary for this continuing post go-live stabilization support.
