ORDINANCE No. 183564

*Authorize acquisition of vehicles for use by City Bureaus at \$302,685 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Council adopted Resolution 35960 to establish a policy for the acquisition of vehicles.
- 2. Resolution 35960 requires the CityFleet Division of the Bureau of Internal Business Services, OMF, to obtain the approval of the City Council before acquiring certain vehicles.
- 3. There is an immediate need for a lease/rental, new additional vehicles, and upgrades on vehicles in the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. The CityFleet Division of the Office of Management and Finance is hereby authorized to acquire the lease/rentals, new additional vehicles, and upgrades per the listed requests identified in the attached exhibits A1 - A8.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists to prevent a delay in acquiring vehicles and the delivery of essential City services. Expediting vehicle procurement will reduce rental costs, increase safety, and improve productivity. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in force and in effect after its passage by the Council.
