

# ORDINANCE No. 183569

\*Amend a grant from the Environmental Protection Agency to add \$817,000 and extend the budget period to September 30, 2012 for Innovative Wet Weather Projects (Ordinance; amend Ordinance No. 177010)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. BES applied to the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) in the amount of \$817,000 for Innovative Wet Weather Projects on November 30, 2009; and
2. EPA has notified the City of Portland that it will award additional grant funds for Innovative Wet Weather Projects to BES in the amount of \$817,000 for a new total grant award of \$3,475,200 and extend the budget period to 09/30/2012, by amendment to the original grant;

NOW THEREFORE, the council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to amend on behalf of the City of Portland a grant from Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) #XP-97045801-5 for Innovative Wet Weather Projects in the amount of \$817,000 for a new total grant award of \$3,475,200 and extend the budget period to 09/30/2012.
- b. The FY 2009/2010 budget is hereby amended as follows:


