- 2) <u>Purpose of the Proposed Legislation</u>: Amend a grant to add \$817,000 from the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) for additional Innovative Wet Weather Projects, bringing the total EPA award amount to \$3,475,200. In addition, extend the budget period of the grant to 09/30/2012. Additional budget and budget period will allow for design and construction of green street projects.
