

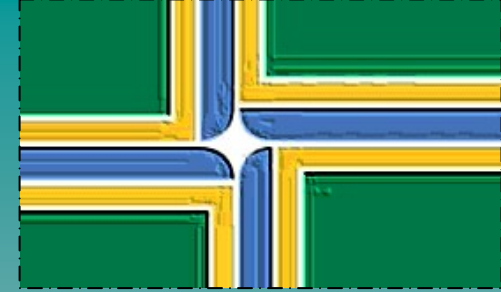

**PROVIDING PROGRAMMING SERVICES TO
PORTLAND'S AT RISK YOUTH**



- **\$20,000 fund made available**
- **To fund 4 private non profit organizations.**
- **Purpose:**
 - **To provide structured and engaging activities to Portland's at risk youth**
- **Grant funds will serve youth during Spring Break - March 20th - 28th, 2010**

Youth Employment Training

- **Engaging 35 at risk youth, ages 13 to 21**
- **6 days of programming:**
 - **multicultural leadership training**
 - **first aid training**
 - **financial literacy training**
 - **job readiness training**
 - **resume training and recreation.**
- **First Aid certification & Food Handler's card**



Community Service, College and Business Exploration

- **Programming offered to 80 + at risk youth ages 15 through 21.**
- **5 days of activities to include:**
 - **recreation**
 - **community service project**
 - **college and career exploration**
- **Offered:**
 - **tours of a local community college and numerous area businesses.**



The Arts - Film Making

- **Supports 30 to 40 high school aged youth**
- **1 week of filmmaking with emphasis on:**
 - **Cultural Brokenness, &**
 - **Violence Prevention**
- **Professionally guided resulting in production and screening**

Structured Sports Instruction & Mentoring

- **29 at risk youth ages 13 to 14**
- **Identified with immeasurable barriers:**
 - **lack of supervision**
 - **poor grades**
 - **economic hardship**
- **5 days of training**
 - **College level instructors**
 - **Special guest speakers**
- **Focus on skills & academics for future success**
