ORDINANCE No. 183609

* Authorize a contract and provide for payment to the lowest responsible bidder for sediment removal from the pond at Laurelhurst Park (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Council set aside funds in the amount of \$1,280,732 for the restoration and aeration of the pond at Laurelhurst Park in the FY 2007-08 CIP budget.
- 2. Portland Parks & Recreation (PP&R) had consultants prepare specifications and drawings for the phase 2 aeration system to be bid, constructed and completed in FY 2010-11. The dredging portion of the work is estimated to cost \$877,000.
- 3. PP&R's level of confidence in the cost estimate for Laurelhurst Park is optimal for the phase 1 dredging construction costs. The purchasing agent is authorized to complete a contract for the construction of these improvements.
- 4. Portland Parks & Recreation estimates that the annual on-going operations and maintenance (O&M) costs for Laurelhurst Pond will be \$18,300 per year.

NOW, THEREFORE, The Council Directs:

- a. The Purchasing Agent is authorized to negotiate and execute a contract to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder, provided the contract has been approved as to form by the City Attorney's office.
- b. The Director of Parks and Recreation, or her designee, is authorized to give any notices or acceptances, to take any action, and, once approved as to form by the City Attorney, to execute on behalf of the City any document necessary to protect the City's rights or carry out the City's responsibilities under the Agreement.
- c. The Auditor to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the Parks CIP funds when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay in executing a contract and proceeding with the project will cause events already scheduled for the summer season in Laurelhurst Park to be cancelled; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
