## ORDINANCE No. 183619

\* Authorize Intergovernmental Agreement with Multnomah County related to the SUN Service Coordinating Council. (Ordinance)

## The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds that:

- 1. The City and Multnomah County are authorized to enter into intergovernmental agreements with other local governments.
- 2. The City and County share a vision for the SUN Service System Coordinating Council to provide system governance, guidance and support to the SUN Service System.
- 3. The City agrees to designate a representative of the Mayor's Office to serve on the Coordinating Council as the City's representative and liaison, and will identify an alternate to attend meetings when the representative is unable to attend.
- The City agrees to pay the County the amount of \$12,000 upon receipt of invoices(s), in support of staffing for the SUN Service System Coordinating Council. Funds are appropriated for this purpose in the Fiscal Year 2009-10 Approved Budget; Mayor's Office Adopted Budget.
- 5. The Intergovernmental Agreement between the City and Multnomah County is attached as Exhibit A.

## NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement with Multnomah County, as outlined in a form substantially in accordance with the agreement attached as Exhibit A, at a cost not to exceed \$12,000.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the General Fund when demand is present and approved by the proper authority.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because any delay in providing grant funding to Multnomah County would harm the public interest; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
