ORDINANCE No. 183632

*Amend Joint Funding Agreement with U.S. Geological Survey for additional work and funding for hydrologic monitoring in the Johnson Creek, Columbia Slough, Fanno Creek, and Tryon Creek Watersheds (Ordinance; amend Contract No. 35641)

The City of Portland ordains:

- Section 1. The Council finds:
 - 1. The United States Geological Survey has been providing monitoring and analysis of Johnson Creek for many years, most recently through a joint funding agreement approved by the Council. This agreement has been effective since October 1, 2004 and was valued at \$388,300 over 5 years.
 - 2. An increase in the amount of \$6,000 to the total value of this agreement is required to cover additional work associated with sediment sampling and analysis not specifically included in the original agreement but appropriate to the original agreement's intent.
 - 3. The established cost is \$6,000. Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY09-10 Budget, Bureau of Environmental Services, Cost Center ESWS000010.

NOW, THEREFORE, the council directs:

- a. The Director of the Bureau of Environmental Services is authorized to execute an amendment to the agreement with the United States Department of the Interior Geological Survey for the purpose described in Section 1, in the amount of \$6,000.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.
- Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because the agreement is expiring. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
