This letter is to modify our current Joint Funding Agreement dated October 1, 2004, to increase the City of Portland Bureau of Environmental Services contribution of funds by \$6,000 for the current Federal fiscal year only (October 1, 2005, through September 30, 2006). This increase is necessary to cover additional work associated with sediment sampling on Johnson Creek, and sample analysis. The purpose of this additional work is to help define the sediment budget of Johnson Creek and tributary streams, and continue to refine the relation of suspended sediment to turbidity in the stream.

All other conditions of this agreement remain the same. The Water Resources Cooperative Program operates under the authority of statute 43 USC 50 which allows us to perform this work. The Oregon Water Science Center DUNS number is 137883463.
