ORDINANCE No. 183633

Authorize a contract and provide payment for construction of the Tenino – Umatilla Fish Passage Project No. E09112 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- The Bureau of Environmental Services has a need to construct the Tenino

 Umatilla Fish Passage Project on Crystal Springs Creek. This is a Grey 2
 Green (G2G) Culvert project, as part of the G2G effort the City will
 replace eight culverts in a five-year period.
- 2. The project is needed to achieve juvenile salmonid fish passage on Crystal Springs Creek. The project will also decrease nuisance flooding, reconnection and restoration of the floodplain, stabilization of stream banks, increase in-stream complexity, and enhance upland and riparian habitat.
- 3. The estimated construction cost is \$1,200,000. The level of confidence is high. Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY 2009-2010 Budget, Bureau of Environmental Services, WBS Element E09112, with additional money coming from grants.

NOW, THEREFORE, the council directs:

- a. The Commissioner of Public Affairs and Auditor are authorized to execute a contract with the lowest responsible bidder for the purpose described in Section 1.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.
