

ORDINANCE No. 183638

* Ratify a Letter of Agreement between the City and Portland Police Commanding Officers Association to modify the parties' 2007-2010 Collective Bargaining Agreement to revise the amount members may contribute to the PPA Volunteer Employee Beneficiary Association Trust (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The City and the Portland Police Commanding Officers Association have agreed by collective bargaining agreement to terms allowing PPCOA to establish the PPA VEBA Trust.
2. PPCOA wishes to revise the amount individual PPCOA members can contribute to the PPA VEBA Trust to Two Percent of Top Step Lieutenant's wage.
3. The City is amenable to the revision to the revision, and the revision would advance the interests of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. That the Letter of Agreement between the City and the Portland Police Commanding Officers Association attached as Exhibit A is hereby ratified by the City Council effective April 1, 2010.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists in order that this compensation action may occur without delay; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from after its passage by the Council.
