ORDINANCE No. 183641

* Authorize a grant agreement with the Third Angle New Music Ensemble in the amount of \$5,000 for the 2010 Beijing Modern Music Festival (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Third Angle New Music Ensemble was founded in 1985 and is the leading contemporary classical music presenter in Oregon, with a significant following of regional and national contemporary music fans. Third Angle regularly presents civic performances, recently participating in the China Design Now exhibit at the Portland Art Museum.
- 2. The Third Angle New Music Ensemble has been invited to perform at the 2010 Beijing Modern Music Festival by Professor Ye Xiaogang, the Festival's Artistic Director, following his introduction to the group at China Design Now. Third Angle is the only North American group invited to this Festival. This recognition is a great honor.
- 3. The City, through its funding of the Regional Arts and Culture Council (RACC), supports artists and art organizations in the tri-County region.
- 4. This invitation presents the opportunity to engage in a meaningful and exciting cultural exchange with Beijing, which will support the City of Portland's goal to increase its visibility in China and to strengthen its economic, artistic, and cultural ties with China.
- 5. RACC supports the use of its funds to facilitate this exchange.
- 6. The Grant Agreement between the City and The Third Angle New Music Ensemble is attached as Exhibit A.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver a check in the amount of \$5,000 made payable to Third Angle. Existing funds are budgeted and available in the FY 2009-10 Regional Arts and Culture Council (RACC) special appropriation.
- b. The Mayor is authorized to enter into a Grant Agreement with Third Angle New Music Ensemble, as outlined in a form substantially in accordance with the agreement attached as Exhibit A.
- Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because delay in funding would create a significant obstacle for the Third Angle New Music Ensemble in the planning of this trip, which will take place in May of 2010; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
