

ORDINANCE No. 183648

Authorize a contract and provide payment for construction of the Ankeny Wastewater Pump Station Odor Treatment Equipment Project No. E09177 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Bureau of Environmental Services (BES) has a need to construct an odor treatment facility to treat odorous air from the Ankeny Wastewater Pump Station and the Ankeny Shaft.
2. Construction of the Ankeny Odor Treatment Equipment has been identified as a priority project within the BES Pump Station Improvement Program.
3. The established cost is \$1,009,000. The level of confidence is optimal. Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY 2009-2010 Budget, Bureau of Environmental Services, WBS Element E09177.

NOW, THEREFORE, the council directs:

- a. The Commissioner of Public Affairs and Auditor are authorized to execute a contract with the lowest responsible bidder for the purpose described in Section 1.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.

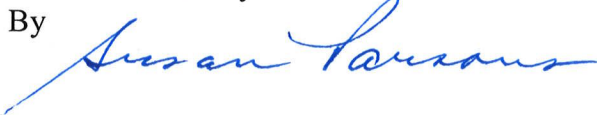
