Authorize a contract and provide payment for construction of the Ankeny Wastewater Pump Station Odor Treatment Equipment Project No. E09177 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Bureau of Environmental Services (BES) has a need to construct an odor treatment facility to treat odorous air from the Ankeny Wastewater Pump Station and the Ankeny Shaft.
- 2. Construction of the Ankeny Odor Treatment Equipment has been identified as a priority project within the BES Pump Station Improvement Program.
- 3. The established cost is \$1,009,000. The level of confidence is optimal. Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY 2009-2010 Budget, Bureau of Environmental Services, WBS Element E09177.

NOW, THEREFORE, the council directs:

- a. The Commissioner of Public Affairs and Auditor are authorized to execute a contract with the lowest responsible bidder for the purpose described in Section 1.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.
