ORDINANCE No. 183651

* Authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement with Multnomah County District Attorney's Office to reimburse for Police Bureau overtime costs on after-hours call-outs on child abuse investigations (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The CAMI Grant provides funding from the Child Abuse Multi-disciplinary Intervention Account to Multnomah County District Attorney's Office in accordance with the grant application and awards.
- 2. The Police Bureau provides Detectives specially trained in conducting child abuse investigations including evening hours and on weekends to respond to child abuse referrals.
- 3. The Multnomah County District Attorney's Office agrees to reimburse the Police Bureau for overtime hours worked by the Detectives investigating child abuse cases during evenings and weekends.
- 4. The agreement extends the term from July 1, 2009 through June 30, 2010 and may be terminated by either party upon 30 days written notice.
- 5. The maximum payment under this agreement shall not exceed \$64,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with the Multhomah County substantially in accordance with the agreement attached as Exhibit A.

Section 2. The Council declares an emergency exists because delay in proceeding with this agreement will unnecessarily deprive Multnomah County and the City of the benefits of this agreement. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
