## ORDINANCE No. 183652

\*Authorize application to the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, National Institute of Justice for a grant in the amount of \$280,453 for the FY 2010 Solving Cold Cases with DNA grant program (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- The United States Department of Justice (USDOJ), Office of Justice Programs (OJP), National Institute of Justice (NIJ) will make awards available to units of local government for funding to identify, review, and investigate "violent crime cold cases" that have the potential to be solved using DNA analysis and to locate and analyze biological evidence associated with these cases.
- 2. The City of Portland Police Bureau wishes to apply for USDOJ OJP NIJ funding in order to enhance the work of the Bureau's Cold Case Homicide Unit's ability to review cases, inventory and review evidence and submit DNA evidence to the Oregon State Police Crime Laboratory (State Crime Lab) for forensic analysis.
- The USDOJ will reimburse the City for limited term part-time investigators, one 0.5 FTE limited-term public safety aide, one limited term, part-time community outreach coordinator, 1.0 FTE State Crime Lab Forensic Scientist I dedicated to reviewing PPB Cold Case Homicides and crime lab program supplies not to exceed the grant application request of \$280,453.
- 4. The grant period is November 1, 2010, through April 30, 2012. No match is required for this grant.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to make application to the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, National Institute of Justice for a grant in the amount of \$280,453 and in a form substantially in accordance with the application attached as Exhibit A.
- b. The Mayor is authorized to provide such information and assurances as are required for the grant period.

Section 2. The Council declares an emergency exists because delay in proceeding with this application may result in not receiving funding. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
