

ORDINANCE NO. 183663

Revise permit charge for sidewalks, curbs and driveways (Ordinance; amend Code Section 17.24.020)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. A number of Maintenance Sidewalk Posting/Inspection Program inspections have occurred permit fees were approved on July 13, 2009, via Ordinance 182894. Though these permit fees were reduced by Ordinance 183348 on November 18, 2009, additional reductions are advised due to existing slow economic conditions. The bureau, in affect, agrees with the business community that permit fees for the postings specific to Maintenance Sidewalk Posting/Inspection Program should be further reduced and made effective retroactive to July 13, 2009.
2. Code Section 17.24.020 sidewalk permit fees for construction or reconstruction of sidewalks and driveways require an adjustment to reflect the new permit fees.
3. A revision to Title 17.24 and to Portland Policy Documents to accurately reflect the revised sidewalk permit fee is required.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:


- a. Amend Figure 2, 17.24.020 (6) as follows:
(6) Construction or reconstruction of sidewalks and driveways
\$.8253/sq.ft \$60.00
- b. Amend Portland Policy Document TRN 3-406 Exhibit A as follows, effective July 13, 2009:
Transportation Service Fee and Rate Charges 2009/10
D. Maintenance Sidewalk Posting/Inspections, Inspection Program – posted notices of needed repairs Postings and Repair Approval Fees
 1. Posted Sidewalks Abutting the Street Area or Adjacent Property
\$.8253/sq.ft \$60.00
- c. Portland Policy Document TRN 3-406 Exhibit A “Transportation Service Fee and Rate Charges 2009/10” is binding City policy.
