ORDINANCE No. 183673

*Award a five year contract with ACS State and Local Solutions, Inc. for photo radar system at approximately \$750,000 per year for a contractual cost not to exceed \$3,750,000. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Photo radar is a method of traffic speed enforcement that is used to detect speeding violations and record identifying information about the vehicle and driver. The City of Portland is in its 14th year of photo radar operation and the program is a cornerstone of the City's efforts to reduce speeding.
- 2. In Ordinance #172517, the City Council directed the Police bureau to deploy the photo radar vans in school zones, highway work zones, residential streets, and SAFE zones. Strategic And Focused Enforcement (SAFE) zones are those locations having a high number of speeding violations and speed related crashes. There are approximately 18 SAFE zone locations within the city.
- 3. The City of Portland's photo radar program has been very successful in reducing speeds within the city boundaries and it has been shown that with the increasing exposure to the photo radar vans, the percent of vehicles exceeding the posted speed limit has steadily decreased.
- 4. Request for Proposal (RFP) No. 109992 was issued on August 27, 2009 for Photo Radar System and three proposals were received. The proposals were reviewed, evaluated and scored in accordance with Portland City Code 5.33. ACS State and Local Solutions, Inc. was selected as the most qualified respondent and received the highest evaluation score. The City issued a Notice of Intent to Negotiate and Award a Contract to ACS State and Local Solutions, Inc. on November 6, 2009.
- 5. This contract will be funded by receipts of citation revenues from the photo radar system on behalf of the Portland Police Bureau, Traffic Division.
- 6. ACS State and Local Solutions, Inc. has a current City of Portland business license, is in compliance with the Equal Benefits Program, and their EEO Certification is current through December 31, 2012. The company is located in Fairfax, Virginia with an office located in downtown Portland, Oregon. Although ACS is not a State Certified M/W/ESB contractor, they have indicated they will source 20% of their workforce from MWESB firms.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. The Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to execute a new contract with ACS State

- a. The Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to execute a new contract with ACS State and Local Solutions, Inc.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver checks payable to the contractor for the negotiated and executed contract and chargeable to the existing appropriation in the Portland Police Bureau budget for a five year total not to exceed \$3,750,000.00 when demand is presented and approved.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would interrupt the continuity of the program, impeding timely upgrades and placement of the City's red light cameras; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
