

ORDINANCE No. **183674**

*Accept Historic Preservation Fund Grant of \$17,000 to support the City's historic resources program (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Pursuant to Ordinance No. 183541, the Bureau of Planning and Sustainability applied to the State Historic Preservation Office on February 19, 2010 for a grant in the amount of \$17,000 to support the City's historic resources program; and
2. The State Historic Preservation Office has notified the City of Portland that it will award a Historic Preservation Fund Grant in the amount of \$17,000 to the Bureau of Planning and Sustainability. The grant will support the City's historic resources program.
3. Local match in the amount of \$17,000 will be provided by funds from the Historic Preservation program, SAP cost center PNCP000001. The match will be in the form of salary, benefits and materials.

NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland a grant from the State Historic Preservation Office for the Historic Preservation Fund Grant in the amount of \$17,000, in accordance with the form attached as Exhibit A, Grant Agreement 2010 for Certified Local Government Grant # OR-10-15.
- b. The FY 2009-10 budget is hereby amended as follows:

GRANTS FUND

Fund – 217001

Business Area – PN00

Bureau Program Expenses– \$17,000

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would unnecessarily delay the City's ability to perform the activities authorized by the grant; therefore this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
