## **ORDINANCE No.** 183707

\* Authorize a contract with Washington State Association of Fire Marshals for a fire prevention program and distribution of smoke alarms (Ordinance; Contract No. 30001104)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds

- 1. The Washington State Association of Fire Marshals (WSAFM) is currently operating a program entitled "The Integrated Risk Management Fire Prevention Program" (Program) which distributes smoke alarms to public agencies that will distribute the same among the residents and businesses within their jurisdiction.
- 2. The WSAFM desires to include Portland Fire & Rescue (PF&R) in its program, and provide smoke alarms to PF&R for distribution within the City of Portland.
- 3. Under this Program WSAFM will provide up to 6,000 smoke alarms to PF&R at no cost, reimburse PF&R up to \$3,500 for public education materials regarding fire safety, and up to \$80,000 for wages for a PF&R employee to serve as Program Manager.
- 4. PF&R currently operates a Smoke Alarm program to provide smoke alarms in the homes of residents of the City of Portland.
- 5. The Fire Inspector Specialist responsible for the current Smoke Alarm Program at PF&R will serve as the Program Manager. Wages incurred for managing this program during the term of the grant will be reimbursed, up to \$80,000.

NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

a. The Commissioner In Charge is hereby authorized to execute an Agreement with Washington State Association of Fire Marshals in a form substantially in accordance with the agreement attached as Exhibit A.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would unnecessarily delay the City's ability to perform the activities authorized by this Program, and increase the fire and life safety in Portland; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
