

ORDINANCE No. 183715

*Accept a U.S. Department of Energy grant of \$276,099 to develop a Local Energy Assurance Plan and agree to the terms of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act for reporting use of funds (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds

1. Portland Office of Emergency Management applied to US Department of Energy for a grant in the amount of \$300,000 for the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act Local Energy Assurance Plan Initiative to coordinate and consolidate local, regional and state energy emergency management efforts on October 7th 2009 (Ordinance No.183229).
2. The US Department of Energy has notified the City of Portland that it will award a grant for the Local Energy Assurance Plan development to Portland Office of Emergency Management in the amount of \$276,099.
3. The initiative will focus on building a regional energy assurance capability to allow cities to better coordinate and communicate statewide and with one another on energy security, reliability and emergency response issues. The objectives of this initiative are to:
 - 1) strengthen and expand local government energy assurance planning and resiliency
 - 2) reduce the impact from energy supply disruptions and
 - 3) create jobs and save jobs in energy assurance planning at the city level

NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland a grant from the US Department of Energy for Local Energy Assurance Plan in the amount of \$276,099 and to execute an assistance agreement in substantially the form of the attached exhibit for this purpose.
- b. The FY 2009/2010 budget is hereby amended as follows:

GRANTS FUND

Fund 217001

Business Area – EM00

Bureau Program Expenses – \$15,000

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would unnecessarily delay the City's ability to perform the activities authorized by the grant; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.


