

**ORDINANCE No.** 183730

Authorize a three-year Intergovernmental Agreement with Portland State University in the amount of \$127,500 to implement Portland's Public Event Recycling Program. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. On June 28, 2006, City Council adopted Resolution No. 36423 that established the following goals for the City's solid waste and recycling system:
  - Promote sustainability of the solid waste and recycling system that includes maximum efficiency, equity and economic vitality, improved worker safety and reduced environmental and human health impacts over the entire life cycle of the materials;
  - Minimize the impact of harmful wastes by targeting toxicity and reducing greenhouse gases emissions;
  - Reduce per capita waste generation below 2005 levels by the year 2015; and
  - Maximize recovery of all waste with a target of 75% by the year 2015 and promote highest value use of the recovered materials.
2. Both the State of Oregon and the City of Portland have adopted aggressive waste reduction goals that rely on reducing garbage and increasing recycling for all sectors—residential, multifamily and commercial.
3. Portland's Public Event Recycling Program provides information, resources and equipment to facilitate recycling, food scrap composting and waste prevention activities.
4. PSU will support all of the major (annually scheduled) permitted events at Waterfront Park, Pioneer Square and the park blocks through technical assistance and vendor education and outreach.
5. PSU will support all interested community events by providing technical assistance, vendor education and outreach and recycling containers.
6. The established cost is \$127,500. Funds in the current year are available in the Solid Waste Management Fund, FY 2009-10 budget, Bureau of Planning and Sustainability, cost object 9PMSWC000005. Funds are available for the remainder of the contract.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor and the Auditor are authorized to execute an intergovernmental agreement with Portland State University for the purpose described in Section 1, in the amount of up to \$127,500.
