

ORDINANCE No. **183762**

\* Amend grant agreement with Sunshine Division to provide individuals and families with emergency food, clothing and household items (Ordinance; amend Contract)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Sunshine Division is a nonprofit organization providing assistance to individuals and families in the City of Portland in the form of emergency food, clothing, bedding and other household items.
2. The Sunshine Division has operated with assistance and support from the City for over 85 years and both parties wish to maintain that relationship.
3. Under agreement the City will provide a lump sum of \$28,000 for the purposes of paying for fuel and depreciation costs associated with food and clothing collection and delivery.
4. Council on June 17, 2009 passed Ordinance 182914 to authorize the agreement for the term of July 1, 2008 through June 30, 2009 for the compensation amount not to exceed \$28,000.
5. The Police Bureau wishes to extend the term of the agreement through June 30, 2010 for the purpose of facilitating payment for the services provided through June 30, 2009.
6. The compensation amount will remain at the originally agreed amount of not to exceed \$28,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to authorize an amendment substantially in accordance with the agreement attached as Exhibit A.

Section 2. The Council declares an emergency exists because delay in proceeding with this agreement will unnecessarily deprive the City and the Sunshine Division of the mutual benefits of the agreement. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
